<p>DEMOGRAPHICS: State demographics on ages of children (under 2, 2-4, 5-8) per county/block group; CHILD CARE: 1) availability of child care vouchers and qualifying licensed centers and licensed family homes per county/block group; 2) numbers/locations/hours/part-time status of local child-care serving programs; 3) Pre-K programs spending per child, availability, access, standards; SCHOOL PERFORMANCE: NC Department of Public Instruction records per county/individual [have experience using]; AFTER SCHOOL PROGRAMMING: resource mapping; CLINICAL: insurance type, primary care home coverage, well-child visits, immunizations (may be available in school registration records); SOCIAL SERVICES: household participation in MEDICAID, WIC, SNAPs, reduced/free lunch, CACFP for child care program, child care vouchers); ENVIRONMENT SAFETY AND LEISURE: resource mapping of active transport (sidewalks, greenways, bike lanes, bus routes), parks/recreation, census block group data on educational levels, employment levels, housing types, crime statistics, and race/ethnicity.</p> <p>A) Mother's reproductive history, specific child's birth history, history of maltreatment for mother & father & other children in same household. B) Mother's mental & behavioral health history (ADHD, depression or anxiety, more serious mental illness, etc.) C) Median income & level of educational attainment for mother and father (primary household caregiver). D) Measure of neighborhood disadvantage, perhaps using the social determinants measure published by NC DHHS. Consider including a measure of perceived racial discrimination. E) Child's birth history including maternal health problems (PIH, pre-eclampsia, substance abuse, etc.), prematurity, low birth weight or small for gestational age.</p>
